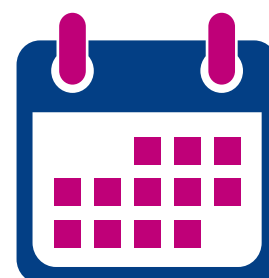
### **What do you think about our ideas?**

# What services might change?

- Sometimes you might need to see a doctor or nurse quickly because you feel unwell, get a cut or infection, or a fever.



- This is called needing urgent care. It is not the same as an emergency where you are so ill or injured that you would need to go to hospital.



- If you need to see a doctor or nurse that day you will usually go to your GP practice.



- If you can't get an appointment, or your GP practice is closed, it can be confusing to know where to go when you need medical help.



- Your local NHS wants to make it easier by making some changes to services near where you live.

## What we think we should do

We think we should change where you can walk in and queue to see a doctor or nurse. **We have 2 options for this.**

We think there should be more places you can book an appointment to see a doctor or nurse on the same day.

We also think people should always dial 111 first and speak to an expert when they need urgent care who will tell you where to go to get treatment.

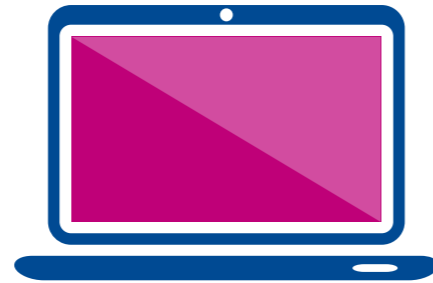


